#### 6U T-Ball Rules

##### League Format

- Buena Vista Youth Baseball is coordinated by the Town of Buena Vista Recreation Department in partnership with the Buena Vista Baseball Association.
- T-Ball games will be played at the Buena Vista River Park Soccer Field (approximately 800 E Main St).
- All players will get an equal opportunity to play. Please arrive 15 minutes before the scheduled practice or game time.
- A high degree of sportsmanship is required of all players, parents, and coaches.
- Games will be officiated at a level that will help teach game concepts and soccer fundamentals while maintaining a fun atmosphere. When necessary, officials will explain their calls to players in an effort to teach. Game times may be shortened if necessary.
- In case of inclement weather on game days, participants will be notified of cancellations by text message, email, and the BV Parks & Recreation Facebook page. Inclement weather on practice days will be determined by the coaches.

##### Game Rules

- Games will consist of 2 innings. Score will not be kept. Games will have a 55 minute time limit, and no new inning may be started after 55 minutes of game time.
- All players available for each team will bat and play the field. A team's turn at bat is finished when all players have hit.
- All baserunners should advance one base on a hit, except for the last batter. The last batter in each inning must continue to circle the bases until they are either tagged out or scored, either of which will end the inning. Runners may be called out on the bases, and should return to their team if they are putout. Outs will not be kept.
- The coach of the batting team will assist the batters, move the tee after a hit, and serve as the plate umpire. The coach of the fielding team will be on the field to assist the players and serve as the base umpire.
- All batters and baserunners must wear a batting helmet. Base distances are 45 feet.
- When the ball is hit it must go at least 25 feet, which is shown by an arc drawn from foul line to foul line.
- If a batter hits part of the ball and part of the rubber tee, it is a fair ball if it goes past the 25-foot arc. If a batter hits all rubber or the ball does not go past the 25-foot arc, it is a foul ball.
- Five complete misses of the ball while batting constitutes a strikeout.
